







To setup your RTK service, press GPS RTK Login, then press Allow While Using App. Enter the information from your RTK service provider and press save to verify your credentials.




To save additional RTK service accounts, press the down arrow, press the action button, then New RTK.






# Bluetooth Setup

Turn on your UtiliGuard 2 receiver. To verify the Bluetooth radio is on, press and hold    
→ Configuration → Settings → Communications → Radio On/Off → On.




From the MyUtiliGuard main menu, select Connect → select your UtiliGuard 2 → Ok.




To setup logging data, press the action button, then press Show Advanced.


Press the padlock to unlock the settings, then check the boxes to select the data to be logged. A maximum of 8 checkboxes can be selected.




Press Start to activate logging, then press Back to exit.



Press the action button, then press GPS RTK Login.




With your RTK service credentials filled in, press Login. You can now stow your mobile device and begin locating.





# Locating

Now on your UtiliGuard 2 RTK, you should see the GNSS data frame. It displays satellite/RTK status, number of satellites, and GNSS location accuracy.



To label a utility on the receiver, press and hold , select Utility Type, then press to select the utility being located. Press twice to exit the menus.




Now locate a utility. To log a point, press and hold .

Note: If a GNSS fix has not been established, a log point will not be recorded.


# Download Job

Now that you have located and logged a utility, you can download the job from your UtiliGuard 2 RTK to the MyUtiliGuard app.

From the RTK Login screen, press Back, press the action button, then Download





Select Ok. Logs will download to your MyUtiliGuard app and can be found in the job list.




Note: Each time the receiver is connected to MyUtiliGuard, you will be prompted to download any remaining logs.

Downloaded jobs are stored in the Job List.




To delete a job, swipe left and select Delete.
